



Locations of Concern – Summary Sheet

Sir Arthur Currie PS (30 Locations)

Location a: Tokala Trail

Total Number of Mentions: 1

Concern:

- Construction vehicles speed and are careless, vehicles speed down Waterloo drive

Location a1: Waterloo Drive

Total Number of Mentions: 3

Concerns:

- Roundabout is too dangerous
- Roundabout is too dangerous for children
- Unsafe due to strangers, and people take left turns for Couldridge Way so need to watch for cars

Location b: Roundabout on Denview

Ave & Buroak Drive

Total Number of Mentions: 17

Concerns:

- A lot of kids cross at this roundabout. Specifically across Denview (as there's no sidewalk on the west side of Denview) and at the end of the day there are a lot of vehicles heading south on Denview. It's just a dangerous intersection.
- Cars do not signal to indicate exiting the roundabout as they should, causing everyone uncertainty - other drivers and pedestrians. Long streams of pedestrians crossing multiple roundabout entrances at once causes backups and delays.

- Cars go around the roundabout so quickly.
- Cars are not slowing as they are approaching and children forget to look for vehicles as they are busy chatting to friends.
- Cars speed around the roundabout and people crossing cannot be seen by drivers because of the plants/flowers/shrubs/decorative things in the center of the roundabout.
- Cars turn without stopping and looking if kids are crossing
- Difficult to see children crossing as cars come through the roundabout - strongly feel there should be a crossing guard there to supervise. Landscaping on the roundabout is also too high - even on regular days going to the park, I find that cars come frequently and very fast.
- I feel that the roundabout is not the safest place for children to cross because of low visibility and higher levels of traffic.
- Roundabout with poor visibility and drivers going too fast.
- Roundabout. Too much fast moving traffic. Everyone impatient and in a hurry. Can't see due to shrubbery in the center of the roundabout.
- Sometimes people don't slow down for pedestrians
- The roundabout is too busy and needs a crossing guard. It is blind for cars on the other side.
- The roundabout makes driving visibility poor
- The sightlines in the roundabout are obstructed by large trees, they need to be trimmed on the bottom to see through. Sometimes there are children playing on



the roundabout. House on corner with 6 large garbage containers on collection day creates a hazard.

- The speed vehicles travel as well as the trees and brick wall in the roundabout make it very difficult to see what is happening around the roundabout.
- This area of the sidewalk has not been properly cleared in the winter and pedestrians are then forced to trudge through deep snow or walk on the street. It's very difficult for families with strollers to traverse when the snow has not been cleared.
- This traffic circle is really busy.. I think it would be helpful to have a crossing guard here..

Location b1: Buroak Drive

Total Number of Mentions: 1

Concern:

- Round a bout too dangerous

Location c: Coronation Drive

Total Number of Mentions: 1

Concern:

- Cars coming from Dalmagarry turning right onto coronation drive speeding. This is the crossing to the park and bus stop

Location c1: Buroak Drive

Total Number of Mentions: 3

Concerns:

- High traffic area for active transport and vehicles. Too many vehicles fail to yield to

those crossings. Also, both at the beginning and end of the day, there are a lot of students using the sidewalks that are all moving at different speeds.

- In front of the school and the school parking lot are crazy!
- Snow was piled high here throughout the winter and made crossing the street at the roundabout dangerous.

Location d: Silverfox Drive & Foxwood Ave

Total Number of Mentions: 9

Concerns:

- A lot of traffic at this corner going too fast makes it difficult for children to cross without adults.
- At the end of the day, there are a lot of vehicles traveling along Silverfox, not signaling their turn and not watching for children crossing the intersection past Foxwood.
- Cars drive too fast around this crossing. Some signs would be nice.
- Cars driving WAY too fast and not paying attention to those crossing at the walkway. Now that this street goes straight through to the next subdivision, cars are going extremely fast and not being cautious of those coming from the walkway.
- Crossing here is difficult. There is a stop sign but many cars treat it more like a yield sign. Lots do not stop or watch out for pedestrians. They are also approaching the stop sign at a high rate of speed making kids second guess whether it is safe to cross
- Lot of children/families walking exiting the cut-through worry about the speed of vehicles travelling west on Silverfox Dr. Upon exiting the cut-through, the children need to cross Silverfox to get to the sidewalk, but a lot of vehicles are travelling too fast





- No cross-walk signs/school children crossing signs. Cars driving too fast. Mailboxes right at cross-walk making it impossible to see kids. People parking on the street blocking views to cross safely.
- Silverfox Dr. is now a thru-street continuing to the west toward new development. There needs to be a crosswalk or other safety mechanism in place to 1) Make sure drivers turning right from Foxwood Ave. give pedestrians the right of way 2) Make sure students are properly checking that it is safe to cross
- This trail is not maintained in the winter and makes it difficult to walk to school in poor weather.

Location d1: Buroak Drive

Total Number of Mentions: 2

Concerns:

- Cars driving too fast
- Lots of car which are too fast and rush

Location e: Silverfox Crescent

Total Number of Mentions: 2

Concerns:

- Cars really tend to speed down this part of the street on their way out of the subdivision, and make U-turns frequently here as the street is wide.
- This road is unfinished, however when it is done my children will have to walk. To me having a child walk over a kilometer one way to school is

too far, when they are 5 and 10. Their current bus is full so the issue isn't that there are not enough kids

Location f: Silverfox Crescent & Deview Ave

Total Number of Mentions: 3

Concerns:

- Another intersection with high traffic levels particularly in the morning, crossing guard might help to keep children safe but also improve the flow of traffic.
- Lots of car which are too fast and rush
- People not stopping at the stop sign. Lots of traffic. The speed people are traveling. The curve in the road leaves little time for reaction from drivers traveling at the suggested speed limit. 50km/hour is too fast here.

Location f1: Silverfox Drive & Silverfox Crescent

Concern:

- Cars turn without looking, also speeding

Location g: Fox Hollow

Total Number of Mentions: 1

Concern:

- We live too far from the school to even consider walking or biking, it would entail negotiating city traffic which my kids are far too young for. At the school I've seen cars double parked, parked facing opposing traffic, parked on the grass/boulevard

Location h: Silverfox Drive

Total Number of Mentions: 7

Concerns:

- Cars are driving WAY too fast down Foxwood Ave!!!!!!!!!!!! Cars come flying around the curve here. My children need to cross from the sidewalk to our house on the opposite side of the street. They have almost been hit numerous times here.





- Cars drive too fast and don't look for children
- Lots of construction, machinery. No sidewalks direct to the school so a lot of walking through unfamiliar neighbourhoods
- Our walk would be much shorter once the path system through this unbuilt area is built. But I don't know what the timeline of completion is for this area.
- Shortest walking distance but no sidewalks or bicycle trails
- The intersection from Foxcreek Rd onto Foxwood Ave has a yield sign. Drivers are sometimes not stopping for kids crossing across Foxcreek.
- Vehicles on Medway Park Dr. travel at high speeds due to the straight away. This is also the location of the new park with paths that exit onto the sidewalk along this street.

Location i: Fox Hollow

Total Number of Mentions: 1

Concern:

- Forest paths are unsupervised

Location j: Denview Ave

Total Number of Mentions: 6

Concerns:

- Cars
- Cars driving too fast
- Cars sometimes drive very fast down Denview Ave
- Just the traffic on the street. Even to just cross the street there can be difficult. Maybe a

cross walk could help increase visibility of the people who just need to cross the street

- Lots of congestion. Poor city planning building a new school on such a small residential street where people are always needing to turn around because it's not a through street.
- This is a high traffic area for both cars and students using active transport to school.

Location k: Silverfox Drive

Total Number of Mentions: 5

Concerns:

- Construction
- Construction and construction vehicles not paying attention.
- Construction zone
- Construction zone - new housing construction.
- This is still under construction. There are no sidewalks to walk on and cars drive WAY too fast.

Location l: Fanshawe Park Road

Number of Mentions: 2

Concerns:

- A lot of speeding vehicles
- Too much high speed traffic

Location m: Tokala Trail

Total Number of Mentions: 1

Concern:

- Bike/walking trail which does not lead to the school and is not maintained.

Location n: Fox Hollow

Total Number of Mentions: 1

Concern:

- The trail is far away and it's a long way for a child in grade 3 to go daily this way

Location o: Buroak Drive





Total Number of Mentions: 4

Concerns:

- Cars are not yielding to pedestrians.
- Crossing the field gets icy, muddy, and difficult to cross with no path across the schoolyard.
- Huge volume of cars turning in front of school; frequently driving on the actual sidewalk.
- Very confusing intersection...one way stop, cars frequently run the stop sign or are unclear if they should stop. Have seen several close calls.

Location p: Tribalwood St

Total Number of Mentions: 1

Concern:

- No sidewalks or bicycle tracks

Location q: Tokala Trail

Total Number of Mentions: 1

Concern:

- Lack of sidewalks

Location r: Silverfox Crescent

Total Number of Mentions: 3

Concerns:

- Many parents drive here and park or pull over to let kids out. At times it can become very busy with vehicles making it difficult for children who are walking across the street to safely see what's happening.
- The number of vehicles traveling through this area. Also people not stopping at the stop sign. Also people who are not

following the rules of the road make it very difficult to teach children what to look for/expect to happen at an intersection like this

- The speed limit should be 30 km/h along the routes an hour before and an hour after school. There should also be speed humps along main through roads.

Location s: Tokala Trail

Total Number of Mentions: 4

Concerns:

- Cars go much too quickly, speed humps are needed.
- Construction site
- Construction workers park on the side of the road here minimizing traffic to one lane. And there is not yet a sidewalk. Cars fight to get by and kids are riding bikes and I'm walking and it's just a high traffic area and the construction workers should be more aware of the children.
- Significant construction/no sidewalks as of yet.

Location t: Tokala Trail and Aldersbrook Gate

Concerns:

- People drive WAY too fast down this road. It's a connector from Tokala and Waterloo and so people just step on the gas. I struggle with letting my daughter play out front due to the car speeds. In addition to that the posted limit is 50. This is too fast
